

Q&A Signal Intent's JavaScript Snippet

Q: Will this be a heavy lift for my development team?

A: No. All it takes is a single `<div>` in the body of your webpage, and a single `<script>` tag in the header, body, or footer of the same page. Our technical services team is always ready to field any questions your tech or security teams might have.

Q: Can I see an example of the embed code?

A: Adding these two lines of code will automatically render the calculator on the page:

<div id='sgi' data-guid='04469aec-f5b1-4d16-8979-11877cbc8bd6'></div>  
<script src='https://embed.signalintent.com/js/embedded.js'></script>
```

Q: Is this embed code going to cause a conflict with other scripts, code, or elements on the page?

A: No. All of the code is written to be completely modular and self contained. It shouldn't interact with any of the existing code, or any of the elements on your page.

Q: Are there site speed concerns?

A: Initial page load should not be impacted by placing the script on the page. However, if your team has multiple scripts in the header, the script can be placed in the footer with little to no impact on load time.
